We are working every day to improve lives in our community. These are some of the positive changes made possible throughout the Coastal Bend because of your generous support of United Way.



•13,105 or 61% of youth participants developed positive life skills – including avoiding negative peer pressure, making positive choices while increasing self-esteem, teamwork and leadership skills

•93% of children were developmentally ready for school as evidenced by motor, social, emotional, cognitive and language skills

•829 or 100% of individuals or families were provided shelter from domestic violence

•63.3% of participants demonstrated increased literacy by at least one grade level

•28,096 or 99.5% of individuals/families had their basic needs met (food, temporary shelter, utility assistance, prescriptions, transportation, etc.)

•3,542 or 92% of participants demonstrated improved consumer skills – budgeting, credit usage and resource management

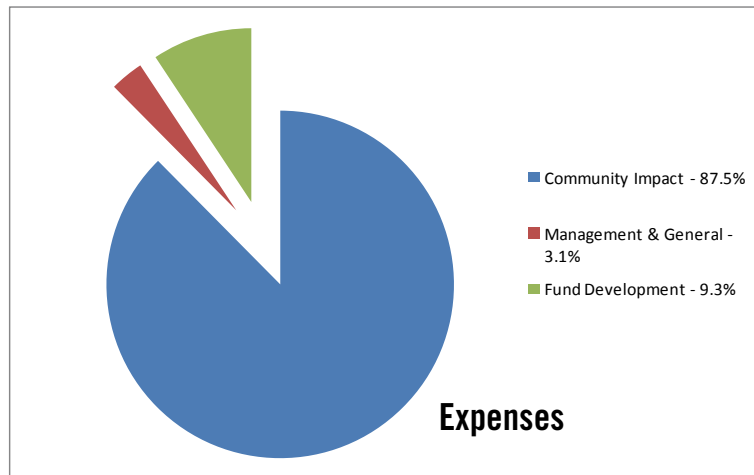
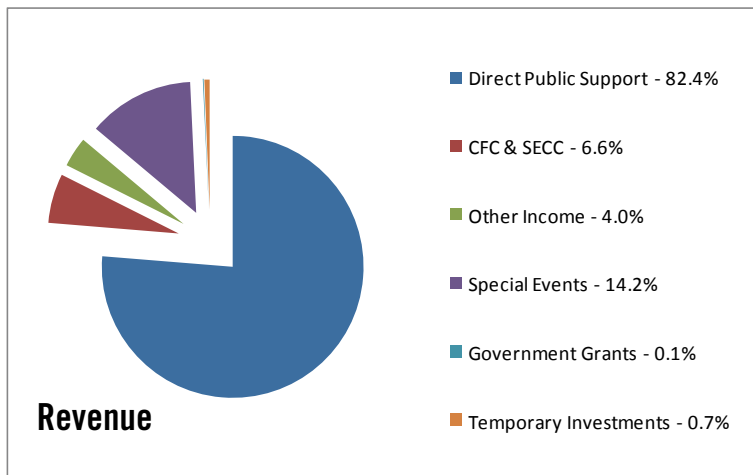


•860 or 92% of infant, toddlers and children met at least two milestones in physical, social and emotional areas of development
