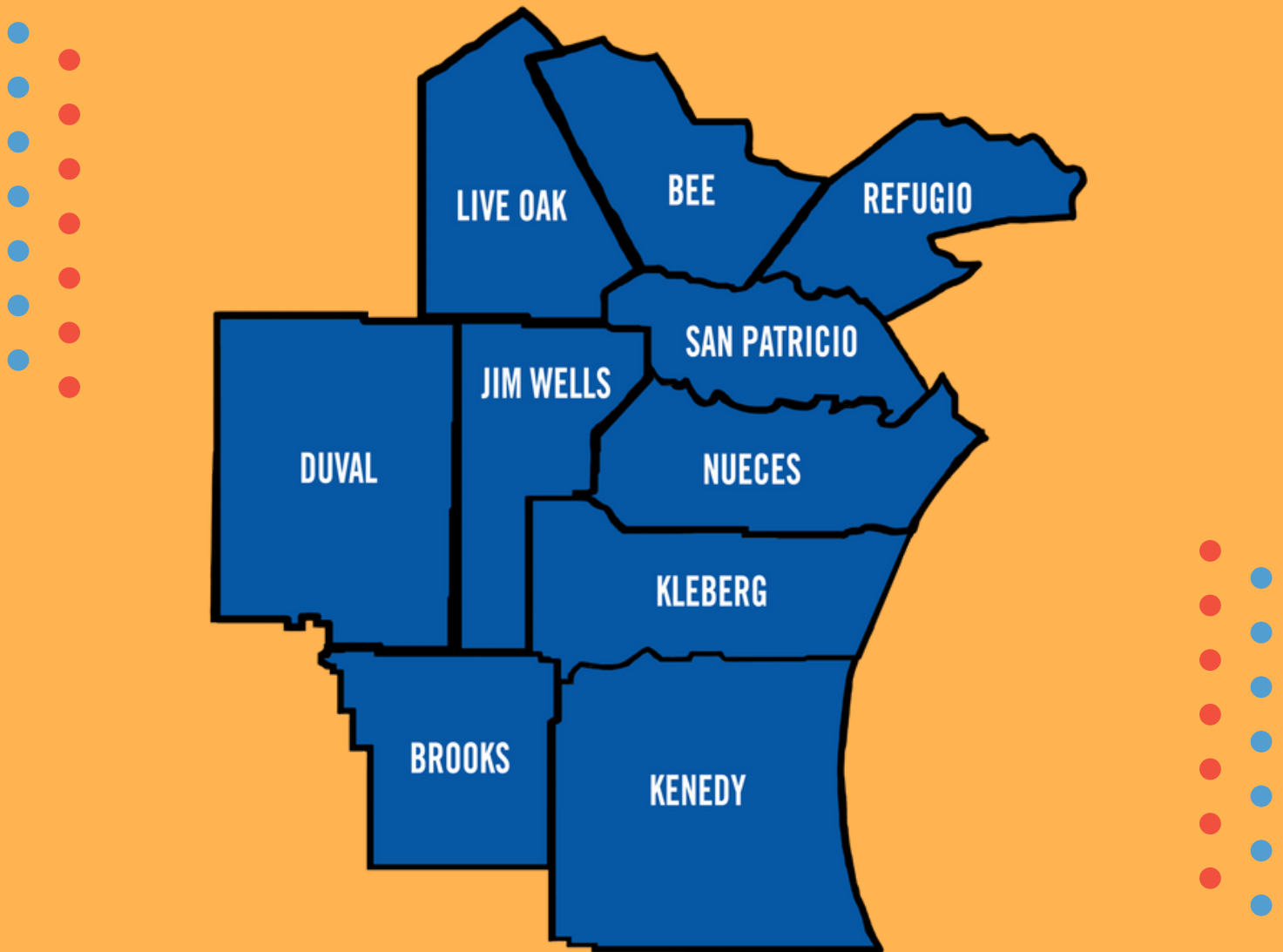

United Way of the Coastal Bend joins forces with thousands of community partners, foundations, and donors from diverse backgrounds and with various beliefs – all with the common goal of creating opportunities and improving our neighbors’ lives.

**Together, we helped 206,973 residents this past year as we continue to change lives in the areas of education, health, and financial stability.**

This annual report covers our fiscal year from July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023, and represents just a fraction of the life-changing work we do with our donors, volunteers, and community partners.

We are an independent, locally-governed organization serving 10 Coastal Bend counties that's proud to say: "What's raised here, stays here!"

We partner with more than 60 agencies across South Texas communities and lead many key programs, including Success by 6 Early Childhood initiative and Operation Supply Our Students. We hosted several free virtual training sessions for local non-profit organizations on topics such as board development and financial best practices.

We also celebrated the second year of our Tocqueville Society, which recognizes individuals who contribute at least \$10,000 annually to United Way of the Coastal Bend.

These donors join a national network of philanthropic leaders who are engaged locally to create long-lasting, positive changes.

Charity Navigator, which evaluates hundreds of thousands of charitable organizations in the United States, again awarded UWCB a four-star rating – the highest possible, and we keep five years of financial records and audits on our website.

Compassion, resiliency, and transparency are all cornerstones of the work that we are proud to do for the betterment of our community. We are grateful for the opportunity to serve and will continue to do so for decades to come. Thank you for joining our efforts to LIVE UNITED.

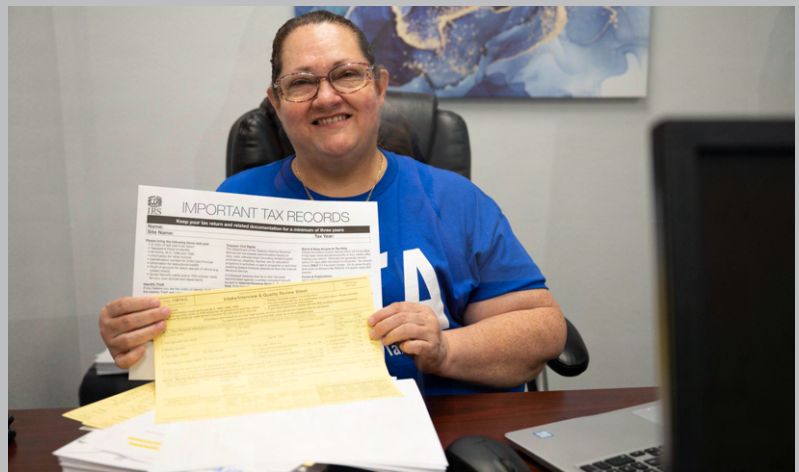

# United Way of the Coastal Bend TOCQUEVILLE SOCIETY

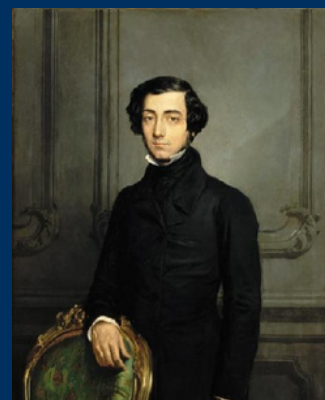
United Way of the Coastal Bend's Tocqueville Society recognizes philanthropic leaders and volunteer champions who have devoted time, talent, and funds to create long-lasting changes by tackling our communities' most serious issues.

Membership in the Society is granted to individuals who contribute at least \$10,000 annually to their local United Way. Founded in Nashville in 1984, the Tocqueville Society is now more than 25,000 members strong worldwide with more than \$9 billion contributed by its members.

Established in 2022, the UWCB Tocqueville Society recorded 15 members in its first year. Current co-chairs are **Erik Simpson**, Vice President and General Manager of Valero Three Rivers Refinery, and **Mitra Khan**, President of Highway Barricades and Services. The Society enjoys small, private gatherings throughout the year to hear from innovative community members in a relaxed environment.

The Society is named for French political philosopher Alexis Charles-Henri de Tocqueville, who traveled to America in 1831 and recorded his observations of the young nation. He applauded and immortalized American voluntary action on behalf of the common good.

South Texans understand that advancing the common good means creating opportunities for all to achieve a better life.

## Women United of the Coastal Bend

Women United is a self-driven, powerful network of local women dedicated to **inspiring and encouraging change** in the Coastal Bend.

The group pools the time, talent and financial resources of its members to bring to the forefront the positive impact women can have on a community.



Our projects have included:

- Writing thank you cards to many groups not often recognized by the community for their service.
- Reading to children at Neighborhood Centers of Corpus Christi.
- Job training at Corpus Christi Hope House and The Purple Door.

## Community Resiliency Fund

Following hurricanes and the COVID epidemic, United Way of the Coastal Bend established an ongoing Community Resiliency Fund to respond instantly to community-wide emergencies.

Because of partnerships in place with more than 60 Coastal Bend nonprofits, UWCB is uniquely situated to respond quickly and efficiently, immediately delivering funds to provide services for those in need. Ensuring monies are on-hand prior to an emergency means people can receive help sooner.

## Board & financial training for nonprofits

To support local nonprofit organizations beyond monetary donations, United Way of the Coastal Bend offered several free training opportunities to help agencies operate more efficiently and effectively. UWCB works with more than 60 nonprofits in a 10-county area.

# Improving school readiness through our **SUCCESS BY 6 INITIATIVE**

Our Success By 6 Early Childhood Initiative is a community coalition focused on improving school readiness in children ages 0-5. Working with local agencies, community partners, schools and childcare centers, the initiative provides resources, workshops and events that are child- focused and family-driven to promote the health and development of children in Nueces County. From July 1, 2022, to June 30, 2023, Success By 6 impacted 2,381 children.



## **Happy Birthday Baby!**

Happy Birthday Baby! is a literacy initiative aimed at strengthening parent-child interactions for bonding and early learning. The initiative provides care bags filled with books, materials and information to families of newborns delivered at local hospitals.



## **Healthy Mom, Healthy Baby! Community Resource Fair**

To raise prenatal care awareness, Success By 6 hosts a resource fair for expectant mothers and those preparing for pregnancy. Attendees receive care items and information about resources available in the community.



## **Read Across America Day**

Success By 6 brings volunteers into local classrooms to read to children for Read Across America Day. The goal is to instill a love of reading from an early age and remind parents how important it is to read with their children every day.



## **Read to Lead Preschool Camps**

Our Read to Lead Preschool Camps support families by providing school readiness activities. Using small group story time with related activities, preschool children engage in diverse experiences that enhance their literacy, math, and science concepts.



## **Week of the Young Child**

Promoting early literacy development in young children, Success By 6 provides a fun, free public event to highlight community resources and engage families in early learning activities. Activities are low-cost/no-cost so they can be easily replicated at home.

## Supporting families through our **HOME VISITING PROGRAMS**

United Way of the Coastal Bend oversees several home visitation efforts for parents of children under five as well as our own in-house Nurse-Family Partnership program for first-time mothers.



### **Nurse-Family Partnership (NFP)**

Nurse-Family Partnership (NFP) is a free community health program that supports first-time moms residing in Nueces county or San Patricio county by having specially-trained nurses regularly visit and provide support early in the pregnancy through the child's second birthday.

From July 1, 2022, to June 30, 2023, the program graduated 33 clients and served 195 first-time mothers.

### **Home Instruction for Parents of Pre-School Youngsters (HIPPY)**

Home Instruction for Parents of Pre-School Youngsters (HIPPY) is an evidence-based program that provides children with a strong foundation to get them ready for school. Staff works with parents to empower them to become their child's first teacher. The program contains 30 weekly activity packets that cover skills in language, math, science, literacy, and motor skills.

The program provides the curriculum, books, essential school supplies, and all visits are conducted in the family home. The program is free.

From July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023, the HIPPY program graduated 17 children and served an average of 58 families.



### **Parents as Teachers (PAT)**

Parents as Teachers (PAT) is a free parent education, family support, and school readiness program for families in Nueces and San Patricio counties with children ages 0-5.

From July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023, PAT graduated nine families and served 104 families.

# Valero raises record \$1.8M for United Way



Valero's refineries in Corpus Christi and Three Rivers raised \$1.8 million for the United Way of the Coastal Bend. The gift came from employee pledges, a company match (50%), and through employee led fundraisers including a Valero United Way fishing tournament. It is the largest amount ever provided to the United Way of the Coastal Bend. A check presentation was held on Wednesday, Jan. 18 at the United Way of the Coastal Bend in Corpus Christi to celebrate the record amount.

"This generous contribution is part of a lasting commitment Valero and its dedicated employees have shown to investing in South Texas," said Libby Averyt, President and CEO of United Way of the Coastal Bend. "That's why it should come as no surprise that Valero holds the distinction of being our top donor company. We're grateful for that partnership."

Averyt also noted that 86 cents of every dollar goes directly to supporting local programs and initiatives in three key areas: health, education, and financial stability.

"It's a great feeling to watch our employees generously pledge their support to the United Way of the Coastal Bend, every year increasing their donations," said Kevin Lassahn, former Vice President & General Manager of Valero Corpus Christi Refineries. "They are inspired by the work done by the United Way of the Coastal Bend in our communities and the support it provides to over 60 local non-profit organizations that help the most vulnerable of our neighbors."

Valero has a reputation as a supporter of United Ways in the markets where it operates.

"Valero is committed to being a good neighbor and community partner. Our employees share the same passion," said Erik Simpson, Vice President & General Manager, Valero Three Rivers Refinery. "It feels good to know we are able to help support so many wonderful organizations that serve the communities where we operate."

Lassahn is a former chair-elect for the United Way of the Coastal Bend's Board of Directors. Simpson is a past board chair.

# Meeting our community's needs through **SPECIAL EVENTS**

United Way of the Coastal Bend takes part in annual events that support education, health and/or financial stability initiatives in our community. We are grateful to the donors, contributors, partners and volunteers who continue to make these events successful.



## **Operation Supply Our Students**

**Raised \$157,839**

United Way of the Coastal Bend raised more than \$157,000, including in-kind contributions, and helped more than 22,000 Coastal Bend students in the 2022-2023 school year. The donations provided basic school supplies to the 43 public school districts in United Way of the Coastal Bend's 10-county service area.



## **Golf Classic**

**Raised \$176,550**

The 29th annual United Way Golf Classic raised more than \$176,000 in 2022 to support United Way of the Coastal Bend's Community Investment Fund. More than 260 golfers participated in the event. The event's Presenting Sponsors were CITGO and Stronghold. Steel Dynamics was the Community Sponsor.



## **Corpus Christi Caller-Times Children's Christmas Appeal**

**Raised \$58,058**

The Corpus Christi Caller-Times Children's Christmas Appeal is a decades-long partnership that ensures children served by health and human service agencies are provided basic needs and gifts during the holiday season. The Children's Christmas Appeal raised \$58,058 for Coastal Bend children in 2022.
